Medical services for individuals located within Mason County

Children's Immunizations

Clinics are held every Thursday from 8am to 2 pm (except the 2nd Thursday)
And evening clinics held in February, April, June, August, October and December
from 3pm to 6:30 pm no appointment needed.

Cervical and Breast Cancer

For Women aged 25 to 64, screening and education for breast and cervical cancer
With pap tests and mammogram referral if you meet eligibility guidelines.
Appointment needed.

Family Planning Services

Physical exam, pap tests, counseling and birth control to prevent pregnancies.

Pregnancy

Test and counseling for expectant mothers.
Appointment needed.

Tuberculosis Skin Testing

Skin test given every Monday (except the 2nd Monday) from 8:00 am to 10:30 am. No
appointment needed.

Blood Pressure

Measurement and recording of blood pressure upon request.

Blood Sugar

Finger-stick blood sugar with risk factors for diabetes and recommendation for
follow-up

Cardiovascular Screening

Total cholesterol and glucose testing with assessment of risk factors, BP, weight,
BMI, and counseling and education packet.

Colon-Rectal Cancer Screening

Stool specimen kits with instruction for take home sampling. Results mailed back to
you with recommendation for follow-up.

Prostate Screening Clinic

Screening includes exam and PSA test. Held annually in September in conjunction
with local physician and health care facility.

Adult Immunizations

Tetanus and pneumonia vaccine available year round at no cost. Hepatitis B vaccine
and MMR at nominal cost for the vaccine.

Seasonal Influenza Vaccine

Annual influenza vaccine offered at no cost for all age groups of the county are
offered October through February as supplies last.

Fluoride Water Testing

Water test kits available upon request for in home water tests to determine the fluoride content of your water supply and needed for supplemental for children age 6 months and older.

Sexually Transmitted Disease

Confidential counseling and testing for syphilis, Chlamydia, gonorrhea, and HIV with preventive education and treatment available as needed.

Hepatitis C screening with preventive education provided
