

Meigs County Health Department

Services Offered by Meigs County Health Department and costs

Immunization Clinic- Tuesdays from 9-11 and 1-3 (9-11 and 1-6 the 1st Tuesday of the month) walk ins are taken. Other hours provided by appointment. Adult Immunizations offered include Tetanus, Hepatitis B (for a fee), and Flu Vaccines (seasonal). Contact the Meigs County Health Department for the Fees for these services.

Family Planning Program

Services include gynecological exams, birth control, STD screenings, pregnancy tests, and counseling. Medicaid and insurance accepted, sliding fee scale is available.

WIC

Supplemental nutrition program for Pregnant women/breastfeeding women; infants and children age less than five years old. Appointment necessary.

Prenatal Clinic

One-on One counseling and education is provided as well as pregnancy testing, nursing services, exams, transportation assistance, and referrals for women up to 26 weeks pregnant. Medicaid and insurance are accepted as well as a sliding fee scale.

Vision Clinic

Free screenings are available to children up to age 21 as well as assistance for Eyeglasses up to age 21. Screenings by appointment.

Mobile Mammography Clinics

For women age 40 and up, or age 30 and up with doctors order. Appointment necessary. Insurance, Medicare and Medicaid accepted. Financial Assistance available for women who qualify.

Speech and Hearing Clinics

Offered in conjunction with Ohio University. Medicaid and insurance accepted as well as providing a sliding fee scale for those who are uninsured.

BCMh

BCMh provides assistance through early identification, referrals and coordination of services for children with medical handicaps

Dental Clinic

Located in Middleport, the Dental Clinic accepts Medicaid and insurance as well as providing a sliding fee scale for those who are uninsured.
